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Imberhorne School Uniform and Dress Code

We are proud of our uniform which is distinctive and smart. We think it is practical and versatile and for these reasons we are precise about how it should be worn. Below is a SUMMARY of the main points concerning uniform and dress code. We expect:

- Trousers should not be tight from hip to ankle nor should they be of a jean or chino style/material
- School skirt must be knee length, and carries the school logo above the hem
- Sweatshirts are to be worn on top of the polo shirt. It can be taken off but not worn around the waist or shoulders
- Jewellery is limited to one small stud in each ear lobe
- Nails should be natural e.g. no varnish or acrylics etc; it is not suited to practical subjects and is inappropriate in a school environment
- Hair to be a uniform style and not shaved, cut very short or have lines/patterns cut into it. We also do not permit extreme colours and therefore request that dyed hair is discreet and natural in appearance
- Shoes must be low heeled/soled and black, not trainers or plimsolls, worn with plain black socks
- All clothing/possessions should be identified with a student's name

What do I do if there are problems with school uniform?

Please provide a note to explain the circumstances. Students must see their Head of Year by 8.45am. If a note is brought from home, the Head of Year can give permission by issuing a green card for one day. If a note from home is not provided, students will be issued with a red card. Persistent failure to comply with school uniform rules will result in a sanction.
