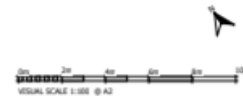

Curriculum

Broad and balanced throughout the key stages

KS3 and KS4:

- Core subjects (English, maths and science)
- PE
- LIFE and RE

KS3: A range of subjects that students may have only touched on at primary school.

KS4: 'The right students on the right courses'.

KS5: 30+ Level 3 Vocational and A-Level courses offered.



Results - 2025

- 70% grade 4 or higher in English and 56% grade 5 or higher
- 69% grade 4 or higher in maths and 49% grade 5 or higher
- Year 13 achieved an average grade of a B!
